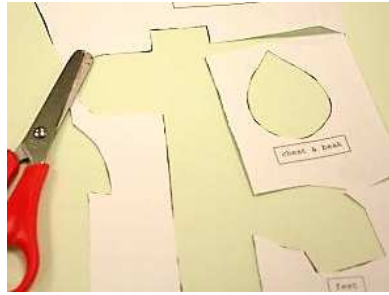


## How To...

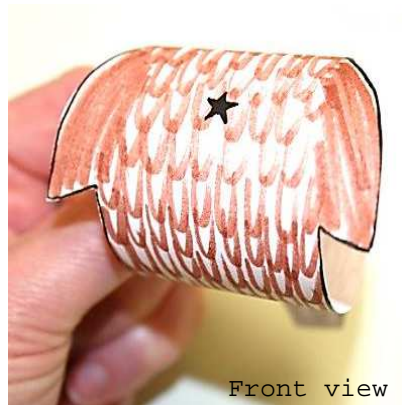
Cut-out the paper bird pieces.

Fold the beak on the dotted line.



Add colour and pattern with felt pens, pencils and collage.

Take the body, wings and tail section and make it into a loop.

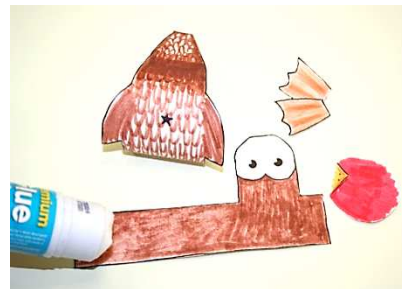


Position the loop by matching the notches with the dots. Glue the loop into place.

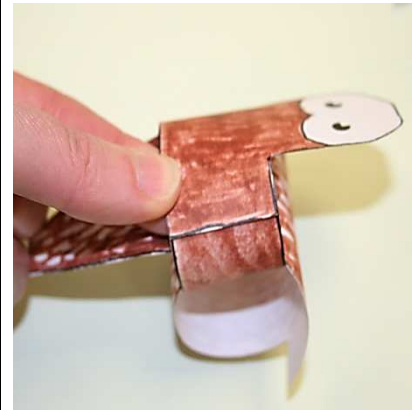


Next link the head section and the body section together.

Add a little glue to the end of the head section, thread it through the body section and join it.



Make sure the bird's face points towards its chest!



Now glue the face to the front of the body section, position it just above the star. ★



Glue the chest and beak in place as illustrated and finally add the feet.
