

## How To - Make a newspaper plant pot Sherwood's Landscape of Trees and Hedges

- Take a sheet of newspaper and tear or cut it in half. Figure 1
- Fold it in half, Figure 2 then in half again Figure 3 and then again. Figure 4
- Turn your paper so the folds and edges match Figure 5






Figure 6 Figure 7 Figure 8

- From the bottom left corner Figure 5 open the top fold and refold it into an arrow shape Figure 6
- Turn the paper over Figure 7
- Now from the top left corner open the top fold and refold to make another arrow shape
  Figure 8



- Refold this shape so the arrow folds face each other (with no arrow folds visible) Figures 9-10
- Turn over and repeat Figures 11-12

- Fold left side top layer to the centre line Figure 13
- Repeat for the right side top layer Figure 14
- Turn over and repeat Figures 15-16








• Fold left and right side top layer to the centre line again, turn over and repeat Figures 17-20






Figure 21 Figure 22

- Fold the square end top layer towards the point.
- Turnover and repeat on the other side.








Figure 23 Figure 24 Figure 25

• Find the middle and look inside, as you gently pull the sides apart your plant pot appears! Figures 23-25

- Finally add compost and plant a seed Figure 26
