

Summer Reading Challenge 2024, Marvellous Makers in Inspire Nottinghamshire libraries this summer

Presented by The Reading Agency and delivered by libraries since 1999, the Summer Reading Challenge is the UK's biggest reading for pleasure programme for children aged 4 to 11. Last year, in Nottinghamshire, over 10,000 children took part.

The Summer Reading Challenge combines FREE access to books with fun, creative activities during the summer holidays and is perfect way to support your pupils' learning during the holidays, ensuring they return ready for a great start to the new academic year.

How the Challenge works

- Children sign up at their local library for FREE and receive a collector's poster.
- Children borrow and read at least six library books, of their choice, during the summer collecting stickers and other incentives along the way.
- Library staff and volunteers are on hand to talk to children about the books they have read.
- Children who complete the Summer Reading Challenge receive a certificate and medal.
