## How to, make a festive cracker decoration

## You will need:

This sheet Coloured pens Scissors Wool or string Glue or tape



1 Cut out the cracker outline. Use pens and pencils to decorate the **reverse** of the rectangle.



2 Fold the short edges along the dashed lines then make cuts through the folds at regular intervals, repeat the cuts along each fold.





**3** Unfold and flatten, then roll the rectangle into a tube along the long edge and glue or tape to hold the tube shape together.



**4** Tie the tube with wool, string or ribbon at the cut areas to make the cracker shape.
